### A. Adventist Health

Amanda Danlovich reported that Adventist Health has an ongoing spot at the Tehachapi Farmers Market, and it generates plenty of interest and community members like to interact with the different departments. 



Initial conceptual drawing of the redevelopment of the Center can be viewed from the file below:






