CEO Wasielewski reported on cash flow, checks written and expenses for the month of October. Cash in was higher than usual due to the accumulation of past 2 months of Kern County deposits. The check register was at \$66,553.88, with \$13,983.88 of it being operating expenses. The remainder was part of the budgeted expenses for the 115 W E Street project. October cash in was \$110,734.17 with total operating expenses at \$24,124.13. Net income was a positive \$89,556.82. Bank account balances were reviewed. Total cash is at approximately \$9,400,000. Director Moats after reviewing the Wells Fargo account activity noticed an unauthorized debit of \$145.00. He asked that Business Manager Ms. Hughes contact the bank and open a case.

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CONSULTANT AGREEMENT

This Consultant Agreement is made by and between Tehachapi Valley Healthcare District and Caroline Wasielewski as of December 1, 2022.

RECITALS

- A. Tehachapi Valley Healthcare District is a California public agency organized and existing under Health & Safety Code section 32000, et seq., located in County of Kern, California.
 - B. Caroline Wasielewski ("Consultant") is the District's former Chief Executive Officer.
- C. The purpose of this Agreement is to set forth the terms, conditions and consideration under which Consultant will provide the services set forth below to District.

AGREEMENT

1. Scope of Services.

- (a) Consultant agrees to consult with District regarding issues that may arise related to her tenure as District's Chief Executive Officer, including without limitation the affiliation with Adventist Health. Consultant agrees to provide the services upon reasonable request of the District.
- (b) Consultant's hours worked shall not exceed 40 hours per month without the District's written consent.

2. Compensation.

- (a) Consultant shall be paid at the rate of \$65.00 per hour for services rendered. Consultant shall bear all expenses incurred in connection with the services, unless the expenses are approved by the District prior to being incurred.
- (b) Consultant shall submit an invoice showing date of work, description of work performed, amount of invoice and supporting documentation. District shall pay Consultant within thirty (30) days of an invoice being submitted.
- (c) District shall continue to pay for Consultant's medical benefits under District's employee plan for three months ending February 28, 2023.

3. Term.

- (a) This Agreement shall terminate on May 31, 2023.
- (b) Either party may terminate this Agreement, with or without cause, effective upon thirty days' written notice to the other party. Consultant's obligation to render Services shall terminate

immediately upon termination of this Agreement for any reason. Rights and obligations accrued prior to termination shall survive termination.

4. Indemnity.

Consultant agrees to save, indemnify and hold District harmless of and from any and all liability, loss, cost or expenses incurred directly or indirectly from any act or omission by the Consultant or Consultant's agents or representatives from any cause or causes arising from or relating to Consultant's performance under this Agreement.

5. Compliance with laws, rules and regulations.

Consultant shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, rules, and regulations in the performance of the Services.

6. Data, Reports, and Documents.

Consultant shall deliver to District on demand or completion of the Services all notes, reports, studies, plans, and other materials and documents related to the Services, which shall be the property of District.

7. Confidentiality.

- (a) District anticipates that it will disclose certain technical, financial, strategic and other proprietary and confidential information relating to its business operations and properties ("Confidential Information") to Consultant for the purposes of Consultant providing the services specified in this Agreement. Except as required by law, Consultant agrees to keep this information confidential. Neither Consultant nor any of its employees or agents directly or indirectly shall use any Confidential Information furnished by or on behalf of District for any purpose except in furtherance of services to be rendered by Consultant pursuant to the Agreement. Consultant will not disclose any Confidential Information to any third party, without District's consent. Consultant shall take all steps reasonably required to maintain the confidentiality of Confidential Information in its possession. The transmission of Confidential Information via electronic data transmission networks which provide for the security of users' data shall be deemed consistent with Consultant's obligations hereunder unless such use is contrary to District's express instructions.
- (b) Upon request by District, all documents and records in Consultant's possession containing Confidential Information shall be returned to District; provided, however, that Consultant may retain copies of documents that may contain Confidential Information which are necessary for the conduct and proper record keeping of Consultant's business in accordance with standard operating procedures or applicable law.
- (c) The restrictions and agreements set forth herein shall not apply to any Confidential Information:
 - (i) which at the time disclosed to or obtained by Consultant is in the public domain;
 - (ii) which becomes part of the public domain through no act, omission or fault of Consultant;
 - (iii) which Consultant's records demonstrate was developed independently by Consultant or was received by Consultant from a third party which Consultant had no reason to believe had any confidentiality or fiduciary obligation to District with respect to such information;

- (iv) which is required to be disclosed by law, including, without limitation, pursuant to the terms of a subpoena or other similar document or information that is otherwise available through the Public Records law; provided, however, Consultant shall give prior timely notice of such disclosure to District to permit District to seek a protective order, and, absent the entry of such protective order, Consultant shall disclose only Confidential Information that Consultant is advised by its counsel must be disclosed by law; or
 - (v) Following the lapse of two years after disclosure of such information to Consultant.
- (d) It is understood and agreed that money damages would not be a sufficient remedy for any breach of this Section 8 and District shall be entitled to injunctive relief as a remedy for such breach, without prejudice to any other rights or remedies available to District under applicable law.
- (e) Consultant shall sign and agrees to be bound by District's Business Associate Agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

8. Independent Contractor

It is the parties' intention that the Consultant shall be an independent Consultant and not the District's employee. Consultant shall retain sole and absolute discretion and judgment of the manner and means of providing services to the District. This Agreement shall not be construed as a partnership and District shall not be liable for any obligation incurred by the Consultant.

9. Subcontracts.

The Consultant shall not subcontract or assign responsibility for performance of any portion of this Agreement without the prior written consent of District.

10. No third party benefits

The parties hereto mutually agree that this Agreement is intended by them to be solely for the benefit of the parties hereto and that no third parties may rely on any reports, analysis or other material provided by Consultant or shall obtain any direct or indirect benefits from the Agreement, have any claim or be entitled to any remedy under this Agreement or otherwise in any way be regarded as third party beneficiaries under this Agreement

11. Miscellaneous.

- (a) <u>Waiver.</u> The waiver by either party of any breach of this agreement shall not bar the other party from enforcing any subsequent breach thereof.
- (b) <u>Severability.</u> It is the intent of the parties that the provisions of this Agreement shall be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law. To the extent that the terms set forth in this Agreement or any word, phrase, clause or sentence is found to be illegal or unenforceable for any reason, such word, phrase, clause or sentence shall be modified or deleted in such manner so as to afford the party for whose benefit it was intended the fullest benefit commensurate with making this Agreement, as modified, enforceable, and the balance of this Agreement shall not be affected thereby, the balance being construed as severable and independent.
- (c) <u>Notice.</u> Notices shall be deemed received when deposited in the U. S. Mail with postage prepaid and registered or certified addressed as follows unless advising in writing to the contrary:

- (ed <u>Attorney fees.</u> If any legal action or proceeding arising from this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorney fees and costs, including those incurred on appeal and in the enforcement of a judgment or settlement.
- (e) <u>Integration.</u> This Agreement represents the entire understanding of District and Consultant as to those matters contained herein. No prior oral or written understanding shall be of any force or effect with respect to those matters covered hereunder. This Agreement may not be modified or altered except in writing, signed by both parties.
- (f) Governing law. This Agreement shall be interpreted and construed under, and the rights of the parties will be governed by the laws of the State of California. This contract is made and to be performed in the County of Kern, California.
- (g) <u>Modification.</u> Consultant or District may from time to time request changes in the scope of the services to be performed hereunder. Such changes, including any mutually agreed increase or decrease in Consultant's charges should be valid only if incorporated as written amendments to this Agreement.


